Paul has been an active APWA member since 1979. He is a great leader and mentor in the Iowa Chapter, serving various roles on the Executive Committee since 1982. In 2016, Paul was named one of APWA's Top Ten Public Works Leaders of the Year. Paul has also received numerous Iowa Chapter awards, including the two most coveted - the Stan Ring Award and the Al Olson Excellence in Public Works Operations Award.
